Quite the Character Scarecrow entries will be displayed south of Acme Farm & Building Centre

Open a world of possibilities as you create a scarecrow interpretation of your favorite television character - human, animal or animated!
Prize: Awarded \$50.00 for 1st place

Kids Only! Scarecrow entries will be displayed South of Acme Farm & Building Centre

Kids 12 and under can enter and should do the majority of creation themselves in a category that gives kids the opportunity to compete with their peers and celebrate the AWESOME power of their creativity!

Prize: The Children will receive the proceeds from the voting for their scarecrow.

School Scarecrow entries will be displayed in the Acme School Grounds

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Please attach your entry form in a Ziploc Bag on to your scarecrow stand with the name of the categories.

2. **IMPORTANT:** Your scarecrow **MUST BE WEATHER-RESISTANT & STURDY** in order to qualify for displaying and judging. Consider the wind and rain when choosing and securing materials to your creation. During the time your entry is on display you may make any necessary repairs.

3. **NO PERISHABLE GOODS** may be used in the construction of your scarecrow (i.e., pumpkins, squash, etc.), and no materials may be put on the ground around or under your scarecrow

4. **Village of Acme is NOT RESPONSIBLE for the security of the scarecrows on display.**

5. Your scarecrow must be brought to the proper destination (Acme School Grounds or South of Acme Farm and Building) Set up is from Friday October 18th and before voting time 1:00 pm VOTING will be on Sunday, October 20th, 2013 between the hours of 1:30-5:00 pm. Scarecrows will be on display until Sunday, October 20th, 2013 after the fall supper

6. **Scarecrows must be picked up Monday, October 21st, 2013 before 7pm.** Any scarecrows that are not claimed and whose creator(s) have not arranged for alternative pick-up by October 21 will become the property of the Acme Royal Purple.

Come on out and vote for your favorite scarecrow in each category. Place a loonie in the can provided by your favorite "Crow." Proceeds from the voting (Excluding the Kids only scarecrow) will go directly to the tri-campus schools, (Acme, Linden, and Carbon Schools) Loonie voting will take place between 1:30 and 5:00pm on Sunday October 20, 2013. Winners will be announced at the Acme United Church 100th Fall Supper.
